### Mini-Guide for Students and Consultants

A person receiving National Garden Club Certification as a Landscape Design Consultant must be a member of a State Garden Club and must have completed all four courses within seven years with a passing grade of 70 for each course. Non-garden club students will receive a Certificate of Attendance from NGC and GCFP.

A subscription to *The National Gardener* is required to earn certification and to take the exam. All lectures must be attended in full to receive credit. Exam not required for non-garden club members. According to the LDSP Operations Guide, present Consultants are urged to repeat Courses I through IV for refresher certification with no exam required.

From PA Turnpike-take Exit 16 Carlisle to I-81 Follow

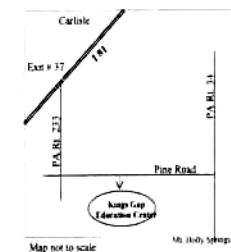
I-81 to Exit 37, Newville, at the end of the ramp turn left onto Rt. 233 South. Go through the 174 intersection, and over a small creek and over the railroad tracks. The next intersection is Pine Road. Turn left onto Pine Road. Go approximately 2.5 miles. Turn right on King's Gap Road.

Proceed 4 winding miles to the top of the mountain.

Follow one-way directional signs to any of the several parking areas. All meetings and lodgng will be held in the mansion.

From the north or south I-81-follow I-81 to Exit 37 Newville. Follow the directions above.

From PA Rt. 34- Turn unto Pine Road just north of Mt. Holly Springs. It is about 5 miles to King's Gap Road, on the left, just past King's Gap General Store.
