

## **PENNSYLVANIA FLOWER SHOW AWARDS**

### **To be presented at Standard Flower Shows only**

The Pennsylvania Flower Show Awards listed below may be included in your flower show schedule but the schedule must be reviewed by the District Flower Show Schedule Advisor. Following that Chairman's recommendation you may apply for the award ribbons from the GCFP State Headquarters, 125 Cedar Cliff Drive, Camp Hill, PA 17011-7775. The ribbons may be awarded at the show at the discretion of the judges.

### **EDUCATION AND/OR CONSERVATION SILVER**

**AWARD - Silver Ribbons** This award may be given to an educational exhibit of exceptional quality, clearly labeled and informative. This exhibit need not score 95 points. An educational and/or conservation exhibit cannot receive both the National Garden Clubs and GCFP State Awards concurrently. The award must be listed in the show schedule and requested on the awards application form. Only one ribbon may be awarded in a show.

### **SPECIAL RECOGNITION AWARD FOR DESIGN**

**Yellow and Blue Ribbons** This award may be given to an exhibit scoring 95 points or more in any artistic design class other than classes listed as eligible to receive a National Design Section Award. There may be only one Special Recognition Award given in a show. The award must be listed in the Awards list in the show schedule and requested on the awards application form. The winner of this award can be considered for the Award of Design Excellence.

### **JUNIOR FLOWER SHOW AWARD - Orange Ribbons**

This award may be given for an all-Junior Standard Flower Show held independently or in the same building of a senior show. The award will be given to the sponsoring Senior Garden Club at the time of the show. The show must be of unusual merit. The award must be listed in the awards list in the show schedule and requested on the awards application form.

## **FLOWER SHOW STAGING AWARD - Gold Ribbons**

This award may be given to the club or clubs scoring 90 or above on the following Scale of Points:

1. Staging carries out the shows' theme in an artistic and creative manner	15
2. Floor plan presents a good traffic pattern with adequate unobstructed aisles and has a well-balanced appearance.	15
3. Entrance is inviting and easily identified	10
4. Lighting is sufficient for the area	10
5. Exhibits in the horticulture section are uncrowded and in appropriately sized containers	10
6. Entries in the design division are well spaced and easily viewed.	10
7. Signage is attractive, legible and appropriate in size.	10
8. Over-all show presented a high standard of excellence which includes Beauty, Harmony, Expression and Distinction	<u>20</u>
